# **Appointment of Engineer as UCD President**

ACEI sends many congratulations to <u>Professor Orla Feely</u> on her appointment as President of University College Dublin (UCD). Orla is a Professor in Electronic Engineering at UCD and Vice-President for Research, Innovation and Impact, and was a previous President of Engineers Ireland. Under her leadership in recent years, annual research grants, publications, citation impact and innovation success for UCD increased substantially, with major initiatives in areas such as sustainability, food, quantum technologies and personalised medicine.

Professor Feely holds a BE in electronic engineering from University College Dublin (1986) and MS (1990) and PhD (1992) degrees in electrical engineering from the University of California, Berkeley, where her PhD thesis won the DJ Sakrison Memorial Prize for outstanding and innovative research. Orla's area of research is in nonlinear circuits and systems, and she has been awarded funding and prizes for her work from many national, international and industry sources. ACEI wishes Orla very well as she takes up the role of UCD President in May 2023.



# **FIDIC Board Membership**

Members are reminded that FIDIC has opened the call for Board members to be elected at the 2023 General Assembly Meeting (GAM) in Singapore in September. There are two vacancies on the FIDIC Board, to be filled at this year's GAM. Completed nominations must be provided to the ACEI Secretariat no later than 9 March 2023 so they can be reviewed by the ACEI Executive Board. Candidates will be assessed against the Board eligibility criteria set out in the FIDIC Statutes. All the required information including the nomination procedure is available in a recent FIDIC communication.
