

RE: - Temporary Traffic Measures and Signs for Roadworks

Date: 02nd September 2019

A Chara,

I refer to Circular RST 02 of 2019 (issued 22nd August 2019) regarding updates to the Traffic Signs Manual (TSM) 2019. The Circular, which constitutes a Direction of the Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport to Road Authorities under section 95 (16) of the Road Traffic Act 1961, relates to the provision of traffic signs and includes, amongst other things, a revision of Chapter 8 of the TSM.

Following on from Circular Letter RST 02/2019 and RST 03/2019, I wish to advise of a number of Guidance Documents that have also been produced in support of Chapter 8 of the TSM, relating to Temporary Traffic Measures and Signs for Roadworks. These are: -

- Temporary Traffic Management Design Guidance (2019)
- Temporary Traffic Management Operations Guidance (2019)

<u>Application of Chapter 8 of the TSM (2019) and Temporary Traffic Management Guidance Documents</u>

The Directions in Chapter 8 (2019) outline temporary traffic measures to be used at roadworks sites to warn, inform and guide road users safely through or around the roadworks site, the circumstances in which roadworks traffic signs and other traffic signs may be used and guidance on the technical and other standards to be followed when they are being provided.

Traffic signs that are provided by Road Authorities at places where roadworks are being carried out on public roads must, under Section 95 (16) of the 1961 Act, be in conformity with the general and particular directions given by the Minister in Chapter 8 of the TSM (2019). A Roads

Authority, contractors, agents, or authorised persons must not use any other format of signs wherever roadworks are being carried out on public roads.

The updated Chapter 8 (2019) along with the Temporary Traffic Management Operations and Design Guidelines are applicable from the 22nd August 2019 and supersede the Directions contained in Chapter 8 of the TSM (2010) of the Traffic Signs Manual (issued under Circular Letter RST 1/2011). In addition the Guidelines for the Control and Management of Traffic at Roadworks (2010) is also withdrawn.

Transition Arrangements

The Minister of Transport, Tourism and Sport has, in relation to Chapter 8 of the TSM and the supporting Guidance Documents, given a direction under Section 95 (16), to provide for a transition period until the 1st of June 2020. The following sets out the transition arrangements: -

- The updated Chapter 8 (2019) applies from the 22nd August 2019. A transition period applies until the 1st of June 2020.
- Organisations using Temporary Traffic Measures and Signs for Roadworks may continue to use Chapter 8 (2010) or the provisions in Chapter 8 of the TSM (2019) on roadworks schemes, but may not combine the provisions of both, for the duration of the transition period.
- After the transition period, organisations using Temporary Traffic Measures and Signs for Roadworks are only permitted to continue to apply the Chapter 8 (2010) Temporary Traffic Measures and Signs for Roadworks standard for works that were tendered or underway prior to end of 2019, with the written permission of the Roads Authority and in addition, for National Roads, Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII).

Availability of TTM Guidelines Suite (Chapter 8 and Supporting Guidance Documents)

Electronic copies of the updated Chapter 8 of the TSM (2019), Temporary Traffic Management Design Guidance and Temporary Traffic Management Operations Guidance are published and available for download from the website www.trafficsigns.ie. Details of dimensioned working drawings for each roadworks sign in Chapter 8 (2019) are also published on this website.

TTM Documentation Suite Launch: Safety at Roadworks Seminar

The New Temporary Traffic Management document suite will be launched on the 3rd of October 2019 in the Clayton Hotel Silver Springs Cork as part of a Safety at Roadworks Seminar. This is intended for senior managers and will include presentations from key stakeholders in the industry including, Local Authorities, SOLAS, the Health and Safety Authority, the Road Safety Authority, the Construction Industry Federation, Transport Infrastructure Ireland and the Department of Transport Tourism and Sport.
